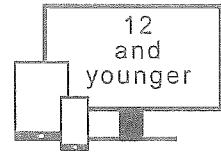

School Internet-based Tools Permission
(FOR STUDENTS 12 YEARS AND YOUNGER)



An important part of student learning in the modern world involves using Internet-based tools to create and share learning while developing digital literacy skills. Students will use these Internet-based tools to:

- Explain and document learning
- Store and manage assignments and other information
- Communicate with other learners

General safe practices will be reinforced when interacting with online service, taking care to avoid posting personal information or personal location that could be used to identify individual students. Your written consent for your child's use of these Internet-based tools is required by British Columbia's Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FIPPA).

The **Internet-based tools** noted below are online services hosted outside of British Columbia and possibly Canada. While stored outside the country, information in your child's accounts may be subject to the laws of foreign jurisdictions, including the United States (USA Patriot Act).

A separate parent permission form will be required if the teacher is using an Internet-based tool that requires a student login or that stores your child's work online, that is not listed above.

While the District will make every effort to close these accounts at the end of June each year, this may not be entirely possible. If you choose not to provide your consent to your child's use of this Internet-based tool, your child will not be penalized and alternate activities will be provided, where possible.

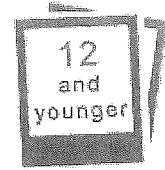
